







Seeking Participants for A RESEARCH STUDY IN SPINAL CORD INJURY

Researchers at the New England Regional Spinal Cord Injury Center at Gaylord Hospital, Hospital for Special Care and Boston University School of Public Health are conducting a study looking at quality of life after a spinal cord injury, a traumatic brain injury, or diagnosis of cerebral palsy.

Subjects will be recruited through July 2013.

Potential subjects must have a diagnosis of traumatic spinal cord injury of any level, complete or incomplete, cerebral palsy or traumatic brain injury and be over the age of 18. Subjects will be interviewed and answer questions about how their diagnosis affects their lives.

The interview will take approximately 50 minutes to complete and can be completed in person or by telephone.

You will receive \$40 in compensation for completing the study.
