

Assessment of Long-Term Health in Chronic Spinal Cord Injury

Investigators at VA Boston are conducting studies assessing factors that may be important in the overall health of people with spinal cord injury, particularly respiratory health and bone health. We hope to assess how respiratory health and bone health change in association with aging and other factors.

The study visit consists of pulmonary function testing, a bone density scan, a blood draw, measurements of height and weight, and several questionnaires.

Testing takes approximately 3 hours and you will be provided with your test results. You will be compensated \$100 for your time.
